The **Final (District) Level** event was held on **18th February 2012** at **Divekar College of Commerce, Karwar**. **Shri VIVEK TANKHA**, *Additional Solicitor General (Direct Taxes) (Supreme Court), New Delhi*, inaugurated the event and gave away the prizes to the winners of the competition.

The event was attended by all the 18 taluka level winners, staff of all the institutions of Kanara Welfare Trust, students and the general public. The inauguration ceremony and competition was held in the Indoor Games Hall of Divekar College of Commerce, Karwar. Media persons, including correspondents from various newspapers, Doordarshan Chandana and other TV channels were also present.

The inauguration ceremony commenced with the invocation, 'Saraswati Stuthi' by **Smt. Bharati Hegde**, Asst. Teacher, Janata Vidyalaya, Mirjan-Kodkani. This was followed by a recital of 'Vande Mataram' by **Shri Devanand Gaonkar**, Lecturer, Divekar College, Karwar. **Dr. R.G.Gundi**, Principal, KWT's Divekar College of Commerce, Karwar, welcomed the dignitaries and the audience.



Introduction of each of the special dignitaries was done by the students of Divekar College of Commerce, Karwar. Garlands and bouquets were offered to each of the dignitaries on the dais and also to the judges of the competition. **Shri Devadatt Kamat**, Advocate, Supreme Court, New Delhi, who has sponsored the P.S.Kamat Memorial District Level Inter - Collegiate Debate Competition, spoke on 'Why this Event?' He talked about the malady of corruption that has infested our country and the role of the youth in tackling this problem. He stated that generating awareness in the youth is the main purpose behind organizing this event.



Dr. M.H.Naik, *Coordinator, P.S.Kamat Memorial District Level Inter - Collegiate Debate Competition*, spoke on 'Debate - Thus Far and Now'. He elucidated about the various aspects in the conduct of this competition at the College level and Taluka level. He thanked all the participating Colleges, participants, students and all the people who have worked for making this project a huge success.



Shri VIVEK TANKHA, *Additional Solicitor General of India, New Delhi*, inaugurated the event by lighting the traditional lamp. Other dignitaries also helped to illuminate the light which served as a beacon in creating awareness among the people by way of this debate competition.



The debate competition commenced from this point onwards. Previously, the participants had assembled in a separate room wherein draw of lots determined whether they had to speak for or against the given topic - *"The Proposed Anti - Corruption Laws/Enactments Will Eliminate Corruption In India."* All the participants were assigned coded numbers - odd numbered ones had to speak 'for' the topic and the even numbered ones 'against' the topic. Rules and guidelines were imparted to the participants. The identity of the participants were not disclosed to the judges and the audience during the course of the competition. The participants went on stage according to the numbers assigned to them and presented their viewpoints on the subject. The thrilling presentation by each of the participants garnered wide-spread appreciation among the august audience.



As the last participant finished his speech, a break for lunch was announced. The gathering was treated to a sumptuous lunch organized by the event managers. A huge tent with seating arrangement complimented the buffet system of serving.



After lunch, the audience was back again in the hall to attend the address by **Shri VIVEK TANKHA**, *Additional Solicitor General of India, New Delhi*. At the outset, he congratulated Shri Devadatt Kamat in taking the initiative in conducting this district level competition. He also admired the drive and resolve of Shri Devadatt, who inspite of his busy schedule in New Delhi, took time out to reach out to his people in his home district. In his words, "This town holds so much for so many people. Rabindranath Tagore could get inspired by this town. In the days ahead, this town would go to inspire the state and the state will go to inspire the country and that's how India will become a better country. The most powerful person would be the person who influences the world with his ideas. It is ideas that change the world. And I am so happy that what I saw today were young minds transforming ideas in a manner that would later on transform the country. And for this I can only thank the Trust which has organized this program."



Shri S.P.Kamat, *Chairman, Kanara Welfare Trust*, gave the presidential address. He congratulated all the participants of the competition for presenting their views so well. He narrated his own experiences while participating in various competitions during his college days. He further elaborated, "In a dynamic society, a dynamic democracy like ours, there is a need for change every moment. A law passed at one point of time is relevant at that given point of time. That's why we have the amendments. Changing society, the changing values, the changing laws. This is a normal thing that happens in every democracy. Changes cannot happen otherwise unless it happens at the level of the man. I am happy about the movement that has happened. This movement of creating awareness and this event that could energize our young boys and girls."



Shri S.J.Kairanna, *Retd. Principal, St. Thomas High School, Honnavar*, **Shri Gajanan Haldipur**, *Karwar*, **Shri L.M.Prabhu**, *Advocate, Karwar*, were the three judges of the debate competition. Shri S.J.Kairanna, on behalf of all the three judges, presented the overall performance assessment of the participants to the audience.



The taluka level prizes along with complimentary gifts were given to the participants by **Shri K.V.Shetti**, *Administrative Officer, Kanara Welfare Trust, Ankola*, **Dr. R.G.Gundi**, *Principal, KWT's Divekar College of Commerce, Karwar*, **Prof. V.R.Kamat**, *Principal, KWT's Gokhale Centenary College, Ankola*. A Titan / Timex wrist watch to each participant was sponsored by **Shri Madhav Kamat**, *Chairman, EAPL Group, Bangalore*.
